Dear 8th and 9th grade students and family members,

We will be going up to Camelback Ski Area this year on **Tuesdays**. Our program runs for 5 consecutive Tuesdays with a bonus trip, IF ALL of our forms and monies are sent to Camelback **before their deadline of Monday, November 2, 2009**. You and your family are invited to ski and snowboard with us this year. We will be using district transportation to Camelback. We will depart from the Junior High School Auditorium exit at approximately 3:00 pm. If for some reason you will not be riding the bus to Camelback, please make sure you arrive at the mountain by 4:00 pm. **Parents or guardians will be responsible for your trip home each Tuesday. All ski club members must be signed out in the main lodge at our designated table by 8:00 pm.** There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule. We encourage car pools. However, you must be signed out by an adult, you cannot sign yourself out. If you fail to be signed out by 8:00, you will forfeit your next trip to Camelback.

If you are interested in participating with us this year, please fill out all forms and enclose cash or a check made out to **STROUDSBURG JUNIOR HIGH ACTIVITY FUND**, and return them in an envelope with the following information: 1. Your Name 2. Grade 3. Responsibility Code

Be a Responsible Skier/Rider

Snow sports can be enjoyed in many ways. At ski areas you may see people using alpine, snowboard, telemark, cross country or other specialized ski equipment, such as that used by disabled or other skiers. No matter what your equipment choice is, always show courtesy to others and be aware that there are elements of risk in skiing and snowboarding that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Observe the code listed below and share with other skiers and snowboarders the responsibility for a great experience.

Responsibility Code

1. Stay in control and be able to stop and avoid people or objects.
2. People ahead have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. Do not stop or obstruct a trail, stop in a safe place for you and others.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.

REFUNDS

- Refunds are issued for Medical Reasons, ONLY. We issue pro-rated refunds for participants who have been injured during the course of the program. The enclosed form must be completed and returned with a Doctor's note. Refunds will be processed and sent to the source of the payment. Please allow 4 to 6 weeks for processing once the form, Dr.'s note and PrePaid ID card have been returned to Camelback.
 - There will be a \$20 processing charge for ALL refunds over \$50.00. Refunds up to and including \$50.00 will be issued in the form of a "Camelcash Card."
 - There will be no rental refunds if personal equipment is purchased after payment has been made.
- I understand and agree to the refund criteria.

LOST OR FORGOTTEN PREPAID ID CARDS

- If a participant forgets their Prepaid ID Card, the participant must be accompanied to Guest Services by their Group Leader. A one-time manual transaction will be processed and the lift ticket will be debited against their Prepaid ID Card. It will be noted on their account. If "forgotten" more than once, the participant must pay for a lift ticket at COD Group Rate.
 - If a participant loses the Prepaid ID Card, a replacement fee of \$25 will be charged.
- I understand and agree to the Lost or Forgotten Prepaid ID Card guidelines above.

SEASON PASSES

- *New this year* – Prepaid Season Pass pick-up will be between November 27, 2009 through December 23, 2009. If season pass payment was made directly to the group advisors, season passes cannot be issued until the program has been paid in full. *(December 24, 2009 through January 2, 2010 is a Black-out Period for Prepaid Season Pass pick-up, due to the high volume of guests over the holiday period.)*
 - If a participant loses their Season Pass, there is a replacement charge of \$75.
- I understand and agree to the Season Pass guidelines above including the Black-out Period for picking up Season Passes.

RENTALS

- We recommend that your child be sure about their rental equipment decision, skis or snowboard.
 - Once the rental equipment has been chosen, no refunds will be issued. If your child is trying snowboarding for the first time and decides he/she doesn't like it, they may switch one time to ski/snowboard rentals by the second week only, of the prepaid program. Refunds or credit will not be given.
 - If your child owns a snowboard, it must have metal edges and strap-in or step-in bindings. Snowboard boots are required. Visit your local ski or snowboard shop for advice on proper equipment.
 - If equipment is lost or stolen, the person whose name is on the Rental Agreement Form will be charged. **Their Prepaid ID Card will be suspended until the charge has been paid.**
 - If purchased your child is entitled to five rentals. If they miss a group visit, the unused rental will remain on their **Prepaid ID Card.**
- I understand and agree to the Rental guidelines above.

SNOWSPORTS SCHOOL

- SnowSports School participants must be age 6 or older
- As with equipment rental, once your child has registered for ski or snowboard lessons, there is no transferring after the **second week of the program.**
- If purchased, your child is entitled to five lessons. If they miss a group visit, the unused lift ticket and lesson will remain on their Prepaid ID Card.
- A paper lesson ticket is issued each week when the Prepaid ID Card is swiped. This lesson ticket is valid only on the date it is printed and will be collected by the instructor.
- When parents are providing transportation, it is the parent's responsibility to ensure the child arrives at SnowSports School on time. Instructors will not hold classes for late arrivals. If a skier/snowboarder misses the lesson, it will still be on their Prepaid ID Card and can be made up at the end of the scheduled 5-week program. The make-up lesson will be with students from other groups, that have also missed lessons. All programs must be completed by March 5, 2010. No refunds for unused lessons.

- All participants age 18 and under, taking lessons, must complete a SnowSports School Release Form prior to the first lesson. This form should be completed by a parent/guardian and returned to the group leader with payment. The SnowSports School Release Form agrees that the child may progress from Beginner (Easier-Green) to Intermediate (More Difficult-Blue) to Expert (Most Difficult-Black) only at the discretion of the SnowSports School. A group representative/parent or guardian must be available to pick up children once the lesson is over. The SnowSports School staff is not responsible for children once the lesson has ended.
- All lessons for children ages 6 through 7 will be taught on the Teaching Hill, the Coolmoor Trail and the Sunbowl Trail. Children this age will not be taken to any other part of the mountain during a lesson. Children ages 6 through 7 should not ride the upper mountain chair lifts by themselves. In order to accommodate them in the program, we will keep them on the beginner chair lifts and in a more controlled area.
- Students may be riding the Coolmoor or Sunbowl chairlifts with an instructor, other students or other mountain guests.

I understand and agree to the Ski /Snowboard School guidelines above.

ABSENTEES

When a participant misses a scheduled group trip, the unused lift ticket, rental and/or lesson will remain on their Prepaid ID Card. They will be able to use that visit after the group completes their five week program. The lift ticket will be valid for the same time-frame their group skied.

If your group visits on:

Midweek Nights	lift tickets are valid, Monday-Friday, Non-holiday 3 PM to close
Midweek Days	lift tickets are valid, Monday-Friday, Non-holiday 9 AM to close
Weekend Nights	lift tickets are valid, any non-holiday, night session 3 PM to close
Weekend Days	lift tickets are valid, any Open-to-Close, Non-holiday session

Lift tickets in this program are not valid during the Martin Luther King holiday, January 16-18, 2010 or President's Week, February 13-21, 2010. Products on the Prepaid ID Card are valid only for the ski season in which they were purchased. The 2009/10 Ski Season is expected to end in April 2010. The Prepaid ID Card is non-transferable.
